

The Bucks County Commissioners introduced a new initiative to focus County resources on ensuring continued and expanded economic prosperity in Bucks County titled "Bucks2Invest." As part of this initiative, the Commissioners directed the Bucks County Industrial Development Authority to administer the following financing programs:

Multi-use loan guarantee program backed by funds held by various county economic development agencies or lenders

Core Industry Fund

Provide direct financial resources to small to medium sized businesses

Bucks Rebuilt

Revitalization and reuse of older or underused industrial and commercial sites New Economy Fund Direct public sector investments into private/public partnerships that promote new family sustaining jobs

Bucks Renewed

Funding source for infrastructure in downtowns and Main Streets

Taste & Tour Bucks County

Assist farmers, agri-business, farmers' markets and tourism

VC4BC (Venture Capital for Bucks County)

Joint venture with Ben Franklin Technology Partners utilizing a \$2 million Bucks County Retirement Fund investment



BUCKS2INVEST'S FIRST LOAN PROJECT Best Made Center, Quakertown Borough



- \$5 million renovation project that when complete will generate approximately 40 new jobs while retaining 107
- Repurposed a 60,000 square foot building Synergis occupies 33,000 square feet
- Owner/Developer Gorski Engineering received \$470,000 in low-interest loans through New Economy Fund and Bucks Rebuilt Program

BUCKS2INVEST LOAN PROJECT Keystone NAP, Falls Township

- \$12 million renovation project that will create 100 new jobs
- Repurposing 62,500 square foot building at the former USX site in Fairless Hills for an advanced Enterprise Data Center using newly installed fiber optics to the KIPC
- Keystone NAP received \$500,000 in low-interest loans through the New Economy Fund and a loan guaranty of \$1.5 million

- Provide training for 40+ individuals during three training program sessions
- Held at College's Advanced Manufacturing Training Center in Bristol
- Training period in Fall 2014 Summer 2015
