

NOTICE OF JOINT PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Bucks County Industrial Development Authority (“Authority”) will hold a joint public hearing on its behalf as issuer and on behalf of Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, as host with respect to a project involving the issuance of tax-exempt obligations to finance the Project described below. The Hearing will be held July 1, 2021 at 9:00 a.m., prevailing Eastern time, at the offices of the Begley, Carlin & Mandio, LLP, 680 Middletown Boulevard, Langhorne, Pennsylvania, at which time testimony and other comments from the public will be heard. Pertinent project information to be considered is as follows:

Project Owner: Richard F. Burk

Operating Company: Little Round Industries LLC, a Pennsylvania limited liability company.

Amount of Tax-exempt Obligations: Not to exceed \$3,750,000.

Location of Project: 2800 Richmond Road, Hatfield Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania 19030 (Tax Parcel No. 35-00-07021-00-9).

Project Description: The proceeds of the tax exempt obligations will be used for a project involving the following: (1) the construction of an approximately 28,000 square foot manufacturing facility; (2) the installation of certain machinery and equipment; (3) the reimbursement or refinancing of costs and expenses incurred in connection with the project; (4) the payment of the costs and expenses of the financing; and (5) financing other proper and lawful purposes (together, the “Project”). This Project will be used for the benefit of the Operating Company in its business of precision sheet metal fabrication.

The public hearing will be held by the Authority as the issuer of the proposed tax-exempt obligations and on behalf of the Board of Montgomery County Commissioners and Bucks County Board of Commissioners in accordance with requirements of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

The tax exempt obligations will not pledge the general credit of the Authority, the County of Bucks, the County of Montgomery or Hatfield Township or the credit or taxing power of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any political subdivision thereof.

This Notice is published in accordance with the public notice requirements of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the regulations thereunder.
